

Never have I ever... HR Edition

Setup:

1. **Seating:** Sit in a circle or around a table.
2. **Tokens:** Each player starts with 10 tokens (coins, paper clips, etc.).

How to Play:

1. **Starting:** One player says, “Never have I ever...” followed by something they've never done at work (e.g., “Never have I ever missed a deadline”).
2. **Responding:** Players who have done it put one token in the centre.
3. **Sharing:** Those who put a token in can share a brief story (optional).
4. **Next Turn:** The next player makes their statement.
5. **Winning:** The game ends when a player runs out of tokens.
The player with the most tokens left wins.

Additional Rules:

- **Honesty:** Be truthful about your experiences.
- **Respect:** Avoid uncomfortable or too personal statements.
- **Participation:** Encourage sharing but respect boundaries.
- **Variety:** Mix up the types of statements.

Examples:

- “Never have I ever had a meeting interrupted by a pet or child.”
- “Never have I ever mixed up two employees' names in an email.”
- “Never have I ever had to explain a bizarre expense report.”
- “Never have I ever attended a virtual meeting in pajama bottoms.”
- “Never have I ever had to deal with an office prank gone wrong.”
- “Never have I ever had to remind someone about the dress code.”
- “Never have I ever had to mediate a dispute over the office thermostat.”
